

Not a book religion but one based on experience. Building on the credo that "The Five Pillars of Islam are the Pillars of Islam", he tells us that religion centers around ritual, not revelation or ideology. Ritual and experimentation are subject to the same conditions. The latter deepens our knowledge of things, the former over immaterial matters, the concrete and the abstract. This book offers every participant a chance to grasp the crisis of Islam as well as the crisis of Modernism in order to find new & better ways to resolve the clash <mark>of cultures.</mark> An eye-opener and multifaceted masterpiece of the art of classic entertainment.
